JUAN LUIS BARRY

LHavana, Cuba, ca.1925- San Juan, 8/21/2004. He studied piano from the age of eight, but also danced. Very young he still left Cuba, acting more as a dancer in Mexico, Venezuela, Colombia, Ecuador, Peru, Chile and Argentina, where he lived for four years. He also toured and performed successfully in the United States. Since the 1950s he settled in Puerto Rico, already more concentrated on the piano, and fully identifying himself with the "farandulero" environment of San Juan. He was a well-regarded performer of the maestro Rafael Hernández, and friend and companion of the exquisite composer Silvia Rexach, to whom In Memoriam dedicated two excellent Lp's with his music. He continues singing, playing piano, and teaching new generations of Puerto Rican singers.
